
ENERGY POLICY

MISSION / VALUE

Olympus aims to maintain a healthy environment and contribute to the creation of a society capable of sustainable development by establishing environmental management systems and reducing environmental loads.

PURPOSE

To confirm the fundamental principles, responsibilities and requirements adopted by Olympus KeyMed to achieve and maintain high energy management standards.

SCOPE

The policy applies to the Olympus KeyMed Group sites including, Olympus KeyMed, Olympus Ireland, Medical Physics International and Algram Group Ltd. It excludes Olympus Testing, Maintenance and Repair Services, who operate under an independent policy. It applies to all persons working for the company; all service providers and incorporates all business activities conducted on and off site but excludes flights and external logistics.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- The Olympus KeyMed Board are responsible for energy efficiency and good management practice
- The Executive Committee ensures that operations are conducted in accordance with energy legislation and other requirements
- The Health, Safety and Environment Department facilitates the operation of the Energy Management System (EnMS)
- Individual employees understand and support the EnMS requirements

REQUIREMENTS

1. Continually improve energy performance by implementing effective energy management programmes and supporting all operational areas
2. Accurately monitor energy performance, investigate any unusually high consumption and take suitable corrective action where possible
3. Set and review energy objectives and targets at quarterly review meetings
4. Implement campaigns to improve staff awareness of energy related issues and involve staff representatives in the Energy Committee and Working Groups
5. Continue to make progress towards reducing the greenhouse gas emissions associated with business activities
6. Take energy efficiency into consideration in the design of any new building projects and refurbishments and the purchasing of products and services where applicable
7. Consider all energy sources, including the available national supply options, to minimise the overall environmental impact and company expenditure
