
ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

MISSION / VALUE

Olympus aims to maintain a healthy environment and contribute to the creation of a society capable of sustainable development by establishing environmental management systems and reducing environmental loads.

PURPOSE

To confirm the fundamental principles, responsibilities and requirements adopted by Olympus KeyMed to achieve and maintain high environmental management standards.

SCOPE

The policy applies to the Olympus KeyMed Group sites including, Olympus KeyMed, Olympus Ireland and Medical Physics International. It excludes Algram Group Ltd and Olympus Testing, Maintenance and Repair Services, who operate under independent policies. It applies to all persons working for the company; all service providers and incorporates all business activities conducted on and off site.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- The Olympus KeyMed Board are responsible for environmental compliance and good management practice
- The Executive Committee ensures that operations are conducted in accordance with environmental legislation and other requirements
- The Health, Safety and Environment Department facilitates the operation of the Environmental Management System (EMS)
- Individual employees understand and support the EMS requirements

REQUIREMENTS

1. Actively follow and promote standards of good environmental management that meet the provisions and requirements of environmental legislation and the approved codes of practice
2. Continually monitor the effect our buildings and activities have on the environment and strive to reduce their impact through improvement initiatives
3. Implement campaigns to improve staff awareness of environmental issues and involve staff representatives in the Environmental Committee and Working Groups
4. Continue to make progress towards reducing our energy and water consumption, waste and pollution levels
5. Reduce the effect on the environment of our distribution operations and business travel
6. Focus our manufacturing and research engineers on products designed with reduced carbon dioxide life cycle emissions
7. Encourage similarly high environmental standards from our suppliers, service providers, contractors and all other relevant stakeholders
